



Rules for Attire in Pennant and Club Championship Bowls

1. Scope of Bowls Victoria Rules for Attire

It is the responsibility of our President and Selectors of the Inverleigh Bowls Club (IBC) to ensure all members observe the Bowls Victoria Rules for Attire, including Bowls Australia's National Merchandise Program (NMP) Logo Policy, which applies at all times when playing in Pennant, Championship Events and Other Tournaments as specified. All members of Inverleigh Bowls Club shall comply with the Bowls Victoria Rules for Attire when playing on any green in Bowls Victoria controlled matches and internal club competition grand finals.

2. Logo

The logo requirements for apparel are defined by Bowls Australia's NMP Logo Policy. This dictates the size and placement of: (i) the NMP logo and of (ii) the manufacturer's mark. Please refer to the NMP Logo Policy for advice on which apparel must have logos now and which apparel must have the logos on replacement. The Bowls Victoria logo is not to be used by Clubs, Regions & Divisions as a replacement for the NMP logo.

3. Headwear

White, Coloured or Registered Club coloured headwear may be worn. Such headwear, in all Pennant, Championship Events and Other Tournaments as specified must have the NMP Logo. White block hats with club hatband may be worn (no NMP logo required). Headwear is always optional; however Bowls Victoria recommends all members protect themselves from the elements at all times.

4. Garments for Pennant and Above Competitions

(eg. Pennant, State Titles Events including Region & Division Qualifiers and club grand finals)

- White, cream, coloured or any Registered Club apparel:
- White, cream, coloured or Registered Club coloured shirt with collar;
- White, cream, coloured or Registered Club coloured garments including trousers, shorts, dresses, culottes, skorts, skirts, slack suits, skirt suits, pedal pushers, jackets, vests and headwear.

If a registered club shirt is worn for pennant, all members of a side must be attired in the same shirt.

5. Rainwear

Rainwear may be clear, white or coloured and worn for Pennant, Championship Events & other Tournaments. Rainwear must have the NMP logo.

6. Footwear

Footwear must have flat rubber heel less soles, manufacturers branding may be on footwear, sandals may be worn without socks, but thongs are not permitted (excluding the "OOFOS O Original Thong" which is permitted by Bowls Australia under their approved footwear -specifically by make/model).

The VLBA/RVBA logos are NOT PERMITTED on any garments for Pennant, Championship Events and Other Tournaments as specified at any time under any circumstances.
