



Membership Descriptions

Inverleigh Bowls Club membership consists of the following categories:

Full Member – a person over 18 years of age in the current year who has paid full membership fees

- eligible to play pennant in Bowls Vic competition (ie Affiliated member)
- entitled to play in club competitions (singles, pairs, 100up etc)
- entitled to be present and vote in general meetings and AGM.
- Entitled to hold office on the executive committee or other committees.

Life Member – a person who has been awarded Life Membership by the Inverleigh Bowls Club to acknowledge their service to the club

- eligible to play pennant in Bowls Vic competition (ie Affiliated member)
- entitled to play in club competitions (singles, pairs, 100up etc)
- entitled to be present and vote in general meetings and AGM.
- Entitled to hold office on the executive committee or other committees.

Junior Member – a person under 18 years of age during the current year who has paid junior membership fees

- eligible to play pennant in Bowls Vic competition (ie Affiliated member)
- entitled to play in club competitions (singles, pairs, 100up etc)

Social Affiliated – not participating in Pennant Competition (weekend or midweek).

- entitled to play in club competitions (singles, pairs, 100up etc)
- entitled to use the facilities of the club for social bowling

Social – not participating in Pennant Competition (weekend or midweek).

- entitled to use the facilities of the club for social bowling

Membership nominations must be received in writing on the Membership Application form. The document must be signed by proposer and seconder (club Full Members) and submitted to an Exec Committee member for voting by the Executive Committee.

All Inverleigh Bowls Club members are bound by the IBC constitution, regulations and Code of Conduct.

Membership Fees are posted on the Team App and communicated to the members. Fees are payable by the commencement of the financial year (1st July)
